As seen from the above table, allotment of rakes is insufficient.

Issues related to Procurement of Levy

1. Nearly 12.00 lakh MTs of paddy is expected to arrive into the market for the KMS 2011-12. The available godown space with the FCI Nellore at present is only 37640 MTs. The GM, FCI may be directed to ensure that atleast 1.00 lakh MTs of godown space is created upto the end of Jan.2012 so that the situation will be in control of the District Administration.

The GM, FCI has already been requested to allot atleast 10 rakes per month from December, 2011 onwards till the end of KMS 2011-12 for movement of rice stocks to places within and outside the State and the same may be ordered to be allotted immediately.

It is requested for allocation of godown space in the adjoining districts also, namely Chittoor, Prakasam and Kadapa for smooth running of procurement operations.

2. In view of the space constrains prevailing in the District, as a permanent remedy, the District Administration has allotted acs.15.00 of land each at the following stations for construction of Bulk Storage Godowns by the State Warehousing Corporation.

1. Chandrasekharapuram, Kodavalur Mandal
2. Bitragunta, Bogole Mandal
3. Bandepalli, Manubolu Mandal
4. Kantepalli, Venkatachalam Mandal

Thus, the Managing Director, State Warehousing Corporation may be requested to take up the Godown construction @ 30,000 - 40,000 MTs per site immediately.

3. In addition to the above, 85 places have been identified in all the Mandals of the District for construction of Rural Godowns by IKP and A.P. Civil Supplies Corporation. Out of which, the Civil Supplies Corporation has sent 20 alienation proposals and site inspection has been conducted.

Thus, Managing Director, A.P.State Civil Supplies Corporation Ltd., may be requested to take up "RURAL GODOWN" construction at these 20 sites @ 2000-4000 MTs per site immediately.

V. MINIMUM SUPPORT PRICE OPERATIONS

The Civil Supplies Corporation has opened 38 Paddy Purchase Centres in Nellore District during the previous crop season (last Kharif 2010-11) and purchased a quantity of 2540 MTs of paddy at 26 PPCs. The entire quantity so purchased was completely transported to the tagged rice mills for undertaking Custom Milling. The entire resultant quantity of Custom Milled Rice (1711 MTs) was delivered to FCI by the rice mills, and this office has already preferred claims to FCI for an amount of Rs.3,30,74,688/- towards cost of custom milled rice delivered.

(v) Movement of paddy to Rice Mills

Immediate transportation of paddy will be undertaken for custom milling of paddy, the District Manager, CSC will arrange the movement of paddy from the PPC to mill point by appointing Division-wise Transport Contractors duly calling the tenders.

VI. AADHAAR

(a) Rural Areas

State Bank of India is one of the enrolment agencies of Sri Potti Sriramulu Nellore District. All the rural areas of the District have been allotted to State Bank of India (4G Identity Solutions Pvt.Ltd). The State Bank of India had started the process of Aadhaar enrolment on 11.07.2011, opened 25 centres in the district. The SBI has placed 100 kits. The SBI has been doing enrolment on saturation basis in one Mandal after the other. 12 Mandals out of 46 have been completed by the SBI and work is in progress in another 5 Mandals.

Till now, 7,08,913 persons have been enrolled out of around 19 lakh people living in the rural areas.

The entire enrolment process in rural areas is expected to be completed by the end of December, 2012.

(b) Urban Areas

The enrolment in the Urban Areas, i.e., Nellore Municipal Corporation, Gudur, Kavali and Venkatagiri Municipalities has been allotted to Civil Supplies Department (M/s. TechSmart).

VIII. CITIZEN CHARTER
