7. DISTRICT SCIENCE MUSEUM

District Science Museum is established during the year 2010-2011 in the compound of Z.P.High School, Chemudugunta, Venkatachalam Mandal. 3 Class rooms were constructed for temporary arrangement of Science Museum. Orders were placed to B.M.Birla Science Museum towards payment of Science exhibits at the cost of 20 Lakhs. It is proposed to construct the permanent building at the estimated cost of Science Museum 70 Lakhs. Out of 70 Lakhs 45 Lakhs is being proposed from R.V.M./S.S.A. and the remaining 25 Lakhs from the donor Sri Vanki Penchalaiah, Chairman, Audi Sankara Institutions, Nellore, Gudur. Steps are being taken up to start full pledged Science Museum from next academic year.

8. IMPLEMENTATION OF MID DAY MEALS PROGRAMME -2011-12

Under the Scheme, 1,53,744 Primary School Students, 64,639 Upper Primary School Children and 42,911 (9th and 10th class students) are getting benefit. The Government sanctioned an amount of Rs.37,62,69,000/- and was released to the Mandal Educational Officers, towards Cooking Cost, CCH, Transport Charges, Food Grains Purchase, MME etc., under the scheme for the financial year 2011-2012. On implementation of the scheme, most of the dropout children were enrolled in the schools.

KITCHEN SHEDS :-

Government of India have sanctioned 3093 Kitchen Schedules to Primary and Upper Primary schools for the financial year 2006-2007 to 2007-2008. Out of which, 194 Kitchen sheds were grounded by APEWIDC department. The remaining 2899 were sanctioned to Engineer in Chief, Panchayath Raj Department duly enhancing the unit cost @Rs.60,000/- to Rs.75,000/- as per G.O.Rt.No.821 Education (SE-PROG-1) Department, dated:15-11-2011.

ISSUE

An amount of of Rs.1,94,85,000/- was released towards purchase of Kitchen divices in the financial year 2008-2009 by the Commissioner and Director of School Education, Andhra Pradesh, Hyderabad only four Mandal Educational Officers have drawn an amount of Rs.9,15,000/- towards purchasing of kitchen divices. The amount of Rs.1,71,60,000/- released at the end of the March, 2009 could not be utilized. The Commissioner and Director of School Education, Andhra Pradesh, Hyderabad has been requested to revalidate and allot the balance amount of Rs.1,85,70,000/- by the Collector and District Magistrate, S.P.S.R.Nellore District vide D.O.Lr.Rc.No.6484/B5(2)/Mdm (DEO)/2009, dated 7.9.2011. The Mid-day Meals Agencies are frequently requesting with regard to supply of kichen divices.
