

## **Minutes of the Review Meeting on Grounding of Loans to Lease Card Holders conducted on 24-11-2011 by the Joint Collector, SPSR Nellore District**

1. The Joint Collector, SPSR Nellore District, Nellore has convened the meeting on grounding of loans to Lease Card Holders with the Co - Ordinators of all the Banks in the District.

2. At the outset the Joint Collector explained salient features of the Record of Rights System, Copies of I(B), Adangal and Pattadar Pass Books and the Title Deeds and also on forthcoming 'Mee-Seva' Kendralu.

3. The Joint Collector further informed the bankers that Adangal copies issued by manually are dispensed with, and Adangal copies generated through LRMIS package (Computerized Adangal) duly signed by concerned Tahsildars are the only authenticated Adangals. While processing the loan applications, Bankers has to keep this in mind and if any deviations or discrepancies are noticed, it should be brought into the notice of the Joint Collector immediately.

5. It is further informed that in the Nellore District nearly 3,00,000 Computerized Adangals were issued since October 2010.

6. It was also informed that the land records information is available at CCLA web site and was updated upto 2011 as far as Nellore District is concerned.

7. The Joint Collector urged the Bankers to speed up the process of release of Bank loans to all the LEC holders (nearly 30000 LEC holders). Further the Joint Collector expressed displeasure over poor grounding of loans to the LEC holders which is even less than 1% of the total allotted target of Agricultural Credit Plan of the District (Rs.1160 crores) The Joint Collector further requested the Bankers to furnish the list of problems being faced by them in releasing the loans to the LEC holders by 7<sup>th</sup> December with reasons after being pointed out by the Bankers while grounding of loans.

**8. The Joint Collector also decided to conduct one day exclusive loan mela for granting of loans to LEC card holders on every Thursday starting from 1<sup>st</sup> December 2011 and on 08-12-11,15-12-11,22-12-11 and 29-12-11 there after, so that the process of grounding will be speeded up.**

9. In conclusion the Joint Collector requested all the Bankers to dispose off all the pending applications of LEC holders and sanction and distribute the loan to all the card holders with out further delay, as the Agricultural season (Rabi) is in full swing and cultivators are in dire need of credit for taking up the cultivation.

10. All the Bankers attended, assured the Joint Collector that they will speed up the grounding of loan amounts to all the LEC holders and will try to meet the District target set by the Collector.
