

NOTES ON REVENUE SADASSULU IN SPS NELLORE DISTRICT.

- 1) During the last one and a half year instructions have been issued to all Divisional Officers & Tahsildars in the District on (i) Updating and Computerisation of Revenue Records in LRMIS Software, (ii) Unique numbering of PPBs/TDs and Weeding out of Bogus PPBs/TDs, (iii) Issue of Computerized PPBs/TDs through LRMIS by carrying out Mutations only through LRMIS and (iv) Preparation of Inventory of Govt. lands by updating the Govt. Land Register, Assignment Register, CJFS Register and POB Registers and generating the same through LRMIS.
- 2) In this connection, since elaborate process have been followed, records prepared and data on various items has already been made available, a programme by name "Revenue Drive" has been taken up in September and October 2011. Accordingly, entire Revenue machinery has been geared up and the printed Adangals, Government Land Register, Assignment Register, CJFS Register and POB Registers were handed over to each and every Village Revenue Officer for updation by carrying out field inspections and thereafter carrying out corrections in Adangals and other records so that there is no discrepancy among records.
- 3) It has been decided to conduct "Revenue Sadassulu" from the 1st to 30th December, 2011, in all the Revenue Villages across the district.

4) All Divisional Officers and Tahsildars in the District have been instructed to conduct "Revenue Sadassulu" with all the Revenue Officials starting from Village Revenue Officers to Tahsildar, in all the villages in the district. The Tahsildars have been directed to attend to the Revenue Sadassulu with all the below mentioned Revenue records, to address the problems of the Public related to the Revenue Department.

- a) Computerised Adangal for F.1420
- b) 1-B Register (Manual as well as Computerised)
- c) Diglot (Scanned Copy)
- d) Village Map (Vectorized with colours to depict various classifications of lands)
- e) Govt. Land Register (Account No.1) - (Prepared from LRMIS)
- f) Assignment Land Register (Manual as well as LRMIS based)
- g) CJFS Land Register (Manual as well as LRMIS based),
- h) Key-Register
- i) Water Tax Arrear Register (based on Jamabandi Accounts)
- j) Register showing the vacant House Sites in acquired lands

5) It is further submitted that the Revenue Officials have been instructed specifically to address the problems relating to Revenue Records, duly following the process, as detailed hereunder

- a) Display the 'Village Map' Flexi board depicting the various classifications of lands in different colours.
- b) Read out the Computerised Adangals for F.1420 and to rectify the errors if any by carrying out corrections in the records.
- c) Issue Computerised PPBs/TDs for all the applications received through Praja Seva Kendras, till 15th November 2011 for all the Patta, Assigned as well as LPS Scheme Lands and also append Unique Number if not done earlier on the balance Pattadar Pass Books.

- d) Issue Caste, Income, Residence, Integrated and Family Member Certificates in the villages by conducting spot enquiry.
 - e) Issue Possession Certificates & House Sites Pattas to the eligible beneficiaries who have been sanctioned Houses under the Indiramma programme.
 - f) Give endorsement on all the applications / representations received through the Petition Monitoring System and also as a part of DRDA SC/ST Land inventory programme which has been received and disposed off after due enquiry, by 30.11.2011.
 - g) Read out the particulars of cultivable Govt. lands available in the village and list of identified land Sivai Jamadars/ Fresh Beneficiaries eligible for grant of Patta under 6th Phase of Land Assignment programme.
 - h) Read out the list of other Govt. lands and update the POB Register to ensure a 'Land Bank' consisting of all the Govt. lands in Mandal Headquarters villages & Major Gram Panchyat; lands adjoining National Highway; State Highway and other Major District Roads; lands adjoining to areas notified under SEZ and Industrial Parks; Land suitable for mining purposes etc.
- 6) It is also submitted that preparatory arrangements have been made in terms of publicity to create awareness about conduct of "Revenue Sadassulu" in all Villages of the District, by printing Pamphlets, showing the village wise Schedule for all the Mandals and display Flexies in the important Public Offices. Adequate arrangements are being made to enable the public to participate fully in the 'Grama Revenue Sadassulu Programme', so as to get their problems connected with Revenue Department redressed in the village itself

7) **PROPOGANDA**

- (i) Awareness has been created in the Public about "Revenue Sadassulu", through 50,000 Pamphlets, denoting the date, time and venue. Separate Pamphlets have been printed, for each Mandal, to elaborate the schedule of the Mandal concerned.
- (ii) 5,000 Posters have been printed and pasted in conspicuous places in Villages concerned.
- (iii) Awareness also has been created in all Villages concerned, about the conduct of Grama Revenue Sadassulu, by beat of Tom Tom.
- (iv) Services of Electronic and Print Media have been utilized by organizing Press conference, in this regard.
- (v) Cinema Slides have also been prepared and displayed in the Cinema Halls.

8) **SUPERVISION OF REVENUE SADASSULU:-**

Senior Revenue Officials have been appointed as Special Officers, for every 3 to 4 Mandals, for guidance and smooth conduct of Revenue Sadassulu. The Collector, Joint Collector and Divisional Officers are also visiting the Grama Revenue Sadassulu

9) So far, Grama Revenue Sadassulu have been conducted in 287 Villages and the following progress is achieved.
